


Accomplished despite rising inflation




Changes to Budget for 2024

- Legal Fees reduced
- Common Grounds Irrigation costs reduced
- Pool Area (Deck, furniture, bathrooms) cost reduced
 - New vendor
- Rick's Pool Service increased
- Cable TV increased by 5% (yearly contract increase)
- Management fee increased 4%
- ELW Community Association increased 7%

Changes to Budget for 2024

- Update reserve study
 - Accurately reflect infrastructure needs to avoid special assessments
- Change in Investment Strategies
 - Invest in CDs to provide a safe investment
- New Monthly Assessment
 - These changes and adjustments results in an increase of only 1.2%


